Second Chance Animal Rescue Society is a non-profit, registered charitable organization that is dedicated to reducing the number of homeless, injured, and abandoned animals in northern Alberta. Since 2002, SCARS has rehabilitated and rehomed close to ten thousand homeless cats and dogs, and in doing so, we have helped communities become safer and healthier.

SCARS also provides education, spay and neuter services, and other resources to families in rural communities where poverty and lack of pet services can lead to animal neglect. Our goal is to help people who own pets to be able to provide adequate care. Healthy, owned pets bond with their families and contribute positively to their communities.

Unlike the large cities in Alberta, there are no "Humane Societies" in most of the small communities. Where no such facilities exist in those communities, SCARS fills that void. While SCARS receives occasional voluntary donations from those communities, there is no sustained or predictable financial support, and no government funding from other levels.
