



# MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD



# **Annual Report 2019**

Second Chance Animal Rescue Society (SCARS) is a non-profit, registered charitable organization that is dedicated to reducing the number of abandoned animals in Alberta. Since 2002, SCARS has rescued, rehabilitated and rehomed over 11,000 homeless cats and dogs, and we have helped communities become safer and healthier.

Preventing pet overpopulation is a big part of what we do. SCARS operates within northern Alberta, partnering with communities that lack access to pet services. Our Spay-Neuter-Return program provides spaying or neutering, vaccination and micro-chipping for owned pets, and our Walls 4 Winter program provides insulated pet shelters.
